

Mountaineers are available from 26'-28' wide and up to 52' long. Space permits up to two bedrooms and two baths on the first floor, plus a full-length upstairs room, which can be finished at a future date for more bedrooms, office — or whatever you can dream of!





Mountaineer Deluxe

Make it a Mountaineer Deluxe! The Deluxe comes 18' high cathedral ceilings over the great room area. Enjoy the wide-open spaces from the comfort of your couch, dinner table or kitchen. Or oversee it all from the loft above. Add to the grandeur with the optional Vista Glass package, which packs the great room gable with glass, letting in bountiful natural lighting.

Looking to expand your space? Even with the vaulted great room ceiling, there is still space for that future office or bedroom in a separate room behind the loft area. Choose a floor size from 26' to 28' wide and up to 52' long to accommodate your needs.











The Musketeer is a great choice for single-story living, giving you the traditional 'cape cod' look, but keeping all your living space on one floor. This makes it a good choice for a retirement home — or for any of the many other reasons you may want everything on one level.


The flat ceilings allow a generous attic space above, accessible by pull-down stairs. If you love porch space (and who doesn't?), this one has it in spades! A 6' deep porch across the front of the home allows plenty of space for your weekend relaxation. The beautiful log railing system not only provides fall protection, but also adds aesthetic appeal.

The Frontier is perfect for your simple lifestyle. Its design includes a great room with cathedral ceilings, overlooking the standard 6' deep porch, which is tucked away in the corner of the home.

As always, the floor plan can be customized to fit the amount of bedrooms and baths you need. With sizes ranging from 22' to 28' wide and up to 52' long you can find a size that fits. It can of course, also be put on a full basement to double your living space. This very popular style has been the choice of many satisfied customers. The Settler is truly a Cozy

Cabins original. You will love the 6' deep full-cathedral porch which spans the entire width of the home. This style has been very popular for second homes and weekend cabins through the years and can also make a fantastic full-time residence.

The many sizes available make it very budget friendly. This is the only style that is available in widths from 20' all the way up to 28'. Lengths are available up to 52' long (including the 6' front porch). So find a size that fits, and remember: Memories of time spent at your log home with loved ones is...priceless!

The roof on the Settler can be made steeper, using our 8/12 pitch roof option as shown at right. This allows the snow to slide off more easily and really highlights the openness of the big front porch.

Custom kitchens are commonplace.
Creating a U-shaped kitchen with a full length breakfast bar on the peninsula (as shown at right, center) makes a great place to eat meals.

The real bragging rights of the Settler?
Definitely its big and open great room.
Tucking the bedrooms in the back of the home and the kitchen and bath along one side allow all the remaining space to be one, open room for living, dining, and entertaining guests.













The Pioneer's beautiful 6'x16'
A-frame porch is perfect for relaxing after a long day at work. The porch protrudes out beyond the main cabin and allows the full building rectangle to be used as living space. How much space? Sizes range from 22' to 28' wide and lengths up to 52' long.

For a more elegant appearance, choose our 8/12 roof pitch option as shown in the right, center photo.

The expansive floor space available makes large great rooms a simple feat (see picture at bottom right).







The Cape Cod







The Cape Cod makes a great weekend cabin or rental. This classic exterior design has been used for log cabins for many generations, and is still a great choice today. Enjoy the high vaulted ceilings while you relax in the great room, or climb the ladder to the loft (over the bedrooms and bath). The standard dormers add to the appeal of this design

This style is available in widths from 12' to 16' wide and up to 52' long. All sizes include a 5' deep porch along the length of the front of the cabin.



The Adirondack makes a great weekend getaway or hunting camp. High cathedral ceilings create an open feel in the great room, and a ceiling fan keeps heating and cooling efficient. Two loft areas are provided — over the rooms in the back and over the porch in the front — giving you extra storage space or two sleeping areas, saving space on the first floor. Both lofts are accessible by ladders.

Adirondacks are available in widths from 12' to 16' wide and up to 52' long (including the standard 6' front porch and loft). Make it your special place to reflect, retreat, and rejuvenate!







If you are looking for a

cute cabin with a full-length front porch, all packed into one efficient package, the Lincoln may be the perfect fit for you. It is a great choice for that weekend cabin by the lake, where you want to sit out and take in the scenery.

The Lincoln is available from 22' to 28' wide and up to 40' long (or even longer by request). Remember that the standard 6' deep porch is under the main roofline and is deducted from the width of the cabin. This means that a 24'x36' Lincoln has an 18'x36' living space. This narrower width does not allow two bedrooms side by side, but they can be put on either end.

This design is a very economical way to get a full front porch since it is in-set under the main roof and is factory-built as part of the cabin module.

So kick back on the porch. It's your weekend. It's your time. It's your cabin.





Single-wide Settlers are a great choice for a weekend getaway, fishing camp, office, campground rental, and much more. This style offers enough space for a kitchen, bathroom, and even one or two bedrooms; and is still economically built in one piece — giving you a rustic, high quality log cabin which can be delivered in a single load with minimal or no on-site setup.

Floor sizes range from 12' to 15' wide and up to 52' long. The 6' front porch is included in the overall length. Custom options abound. The layout you need will vary greatly, depending on your use. Are you renting the cabin and need plenty of sleeping space? We can arrange the bedroom windows so your bunk bed and full-size bed both fit and make the living area large enough for a futon which can double as an extra sleeping space. Enjoy the simple life. It all starts with your cabin in the woods.

Options & Inspiration







































Our knotty pine kitchens provide that primitive feel that blends so well with the theme. But don't begin to think the construction is old-fashioned! All drawers are soft-close (so no more slamming drawers!) and have full-extension slides. All our kitchens are solid-wood construction with dovetail drawer boxes. A double-bowl stainless steel sink with faucet (Moen brand) is installed in the standard laminate counter top. A range hood is provided to whisk away the fumes while you cook.



Our bathrooms are complete, including even the hand towel rack and toilet paper holder. All showers and tubs are one-piece fiberglass units, so there is no need to worry about leaks. Pedestal sinks or solid pine vanities are used, depending on the floor plan (upgraded maple vanity shown), and have a mirror over them. All our bathrooms have vinyl flooring (realistic tile pattern) so you don't have to worry about the floor getting wet.

























Quality lighting fixtures are a standard part of our packages. All bedrooms and living areas include ceiling fans automatically.



Solid wood yellow pine flooring is a standard part of our packages. It is ¾" tongue and groove, and is installed over the standard ¾" tongue & groove oriental strand board sub floor.



Remember those deep window sills on the old farm house? Our window sills are a full 8"deep and artfully crafted by our talented craftsmen.



All interior doors (bedroom, bath, and closet) are knotty pine and solid wood construction.



Shelving is included in all our closets. Coat closets and bedroom closets have one 12" shelf with a rod, while pantries and linen closets have four 16" deep shelves.

All our homes are prefabricated using modular techniques. The modular sections are built stronger than traditionally framed homes to ensure structural integrity during transit.

- 2x10 floor joists 16" O.C.
- ¾" tongue & groove sub-floor glued and nailed to joists
- Pressure-treated porch decking (composite decking upgrade available)
- 2x6 framed exterior walls studs spaced 16" O.C.
- Walls sheathed with %6" OSB and house wrapped
- White pine tongue & groove log siding
- Round log railings on porches
- Two coats of exterior sealer applied in factory
- Insulated windows with low-e/argon glass (0.32 u-factor)

- Insulated fiberglass 6-panel entrance door
- 2x10 roof rafters @ 16" O.C. or engineered trusses @ 24" O.C.
- 7/16" OSB roof sheathing with felt paper above
- Lifetime GAF/Elk architectural shingle roof (steel roof is optional)
- Insulation packages to meet or exceed your local energy codes
- **Our Recreational Cabins (not available in all areas) are often built on pressure treated 4x4 skids with 2x6 pressure treated floor joists. Exterior walls are 2x4 and roof systems are typically 2x6 or 2x8, and insulation values are reduced. These cabins are a perfect choice for weekend getaways, and hunting cabins where full-time living is not the intent, and residential code requirements not required.
